

Walkin' Wild

Discover wildlife in our backyard along the North Columbia Slough. Keep your eye out for eagles, ducks, herons and cormorants. Wander through the park at the Treatment Plant which features great wildlife related art and travel along the great new sidewalk on N Columbia Blvd. One trailhead is a half mile walk from either Kenton or Delta Park stations.

Accessibility: Access to the trailhead along N Denver is difficult; the trail is hard-packed gravel and there are paved sidewalks from the Treatment Plant.



BEGIN at Paul Bunyan statue across from the Kenton/N Denver MAX Station

1. Cross N Interstate and MAX tracks to eastside of N Denver
2. Walk north along N Denver, across the N Denver Viaduct
3. Cross to traffic island at N Schmeer
4. Cross over N Denver at N Schmeer Road to Columbia Slough Trailhead
5. Walk west along the Columbia Slough Trail under the railroad overpass
6. Turn left onto the pedestrian bridge and follow trail around to the left, through to N Columbia Blvd.
7. Turn right along trail that parallels N Columbia Way to N Portsmouth
8. Cross N Columbia Blvd with signal at N Portsmouth
9. Turn left and walk along N Columbia Blvd path
10. Angle right up slight hill on N Argyle to N Denver back to Paul Bunyan
